## Easy Otabor and Nike To Open 'Sole Perspectives' Exhibition Honoring the Air Force 1

Taking place in Miami, the multi-medium showcase will feature the work of 20 artists.

Easy Otabor, owner and curator of Chicago's Anthony Gallery, has joined forces with Nike (NYSE:NKE -0.82%) to produce a group exhibition highlighting the Air Force 1's timeless influence, during Art Basel Miami. Titled Sole Perspectives, the showcase will platform 20 artists whose work pays homage to the signature sneaker across a wide range of mediums, including photography, painting, collage, sculpture and video.

The featured artists, which include Andrew Park, Bradley Ward, Henry Swanson, Jewel Ham, Lindsay Dawn, Michael C. Thorpe and Okey Ofomata, among others, exist "at the intersection of fashion, sport, and contemporary art," per Otabor.

The exhibition's official description reads: "Varied media and subject matter speak to a universal language of style that transcends time, geography, or utilitarian purpose— aims that have been integral to the development of brand identity and apparel throughout Nike's illustrious history. The undeniable thread of the sneaker's influence throughout these artworks celebrates a unification of communities through the collective appreciation of design and aesthetics."

Sole Perspectives will be on view at 3408 NW 7th Ave, Miami, FL 33127 from December 9 to 10. On December 9, there will be a raffle for a limited-edition pair of Air Force 1's designed by Michael C.
